





Charles GOUNOD (1818–1893) La Nonne sanglante ('The Bleeding Nun')

Libretto by Eugène Scribe and Germain Delavigne

The plot of Gounod's opera La Nonne sanglante ('The Bleeding Nun') is drawn from Matthew Lewis's once famous 1796 novel The Monk. The subject is a Gothic melodrama featuring warring families, two lovers, and the vengeful spectre of the Nun, to which Gounod responds with music that fuses Romanticism with the supernatural on the grandest scale. This ground-breaking production features memorable set pieces enhanced by the stark drama of the stage setting and brilliant cinematic lighting effects.

Key Features:

- Gounod's work is unjustly forgotten after its premiere in 1854. In 2008 the opera was produced for the first time on a German stage, and in 2018 had a rare Paris revival at the Opéra Comique, in commemoration of the bicentenary of the composer's birth, staged by David Bobée.
- Opera News wrote about the performance: The production was directed by David Bobée and conducted by Laurence Equilbey, leading her Insula orchestra of period instruments with passion and precision. There was a 'Hammer Horror' quality to Bobée's direction of the cast; the crowd scenes were particularly successful, with the Accentus chorus and the dancers caught in a chaotic maelstrom of cinematic movement, which had a naturalism rarely seen on the opera stage.
- In praise of the cast, *Opera News* added: 'Another reason for the rarity of revivals of this

opera is the demands that the score places on the singers, particularly in the central role of Rodolphe. Tenor **Michael Spyres** conquered the wide range of the role with disconcerting ease, combining caressing lyricism with firm heroism when required. His perfect French

diction and tireless commitment more than warranted his triumphant reception... As the bleeding nun, mezzo Marion Lebègue had the right touch of the sepulcher in her voice while rising to defiant heights where necessary and acting with a ghostly air of glazed, eye-rolling intensity. As the ill-fated Agnès – a character in a constant state of distress – the attractive soprano Vannina Santoni provided some thrilling high notes on the edge of her vocal possibilities.'

First performed in 1865, Amleto ('Hamlet') represented a radical new development in Italian opera, the nuovo melodramma. Composer Franco Faccio and his librettist Arrigo Boito sought a greater degree of musical unity in staged productions and a more equal relationship between text and music. In Hamlet, a play that many then considered un-operatic, they found the perfect medium through which to explore the work's philosophical and dramatic power - not least the great set-piece scenes: Amleto's soliloquy 'Essere o non essere!' ('To be or not to be'), Ofelia's Mad Scene and the fight scenes - in a way that strikingly prefigures the verismo operas yet to come.

About Paolo Carignani

Paolo Carignani conducts in many Italian opera houses and international venues such as the Wiener Staatsoper, the Staatsoper Berlin, the Deutsche Oper Berlin, the Bayerische Staatsoper, the Metropolitan Opera in New York, the Royal Opera House, Covent Garden, and at the Rossini Opera Festival in Pesaro. Among his recent engagements are Il trovatore, Falstaff, Otello, La traviata, Macbeth, Nabucco and Norma in Munich, Giovanna d'Arco at the Salzburger Festspiele, Nabucco, Tosca and Andrea Chénier in Vienna, Otello in Zurich, Tosca in Barcelona, Turandot and Carmen at the Bregenzer Festspiele, and Turandot, Carmen and La Bohème in New York.

Migrations provides a generous view of Derek Bermel's superb craftsmanship and eclectic style, in which classical forms, world music, jazz, blues and American folk music create a mix that reaches directly into the body and the heart. Commissioned by Wynton Marsalis, Migration Series has its roots in African American music, its impeccable counterpoint and biting rhythms expressed through orchestration that sounds like a city coming to life. Mar de Setembro was inspired by Luciana Souza's bell-toned voice and the intense feelings of Portuguese saudade, while A Shout, a Whisper, and a Trace honors Bartók's last years in New York, referring to the Concerto for Orchestra as well as to jazz and Balkan music.

GRAMMY® Award-winning conductor **David Alan Miller** has established a reputation as one of the leading American conductors of his generation. Music director of the **Albany Symphony** since 1992, Miller has proven himself a creative and compelling orchestra builder. Through exploration of unusual repertoire, educational programming, community outreach and recording initiatives, he has reaffirmed the Albany Symphony's reputation as one of the nation's leading champions of American symphonic music and most innovative orchestras. A native of Los Angeles, Miller holds a Bachelor's degree from the University of California, Berkeley and a Master's degree in orchestral conducting from The Juilliard School.





Ludwig van BEETHOVEN (1770–1827) The Creatures of Prometheus Version for Piano

Warren Lee, Piano

Ludwig van Beethoven was commissioned by the dancer and choreographer Salvatore Viganò to write the ballet *The Creatures of Prometheus* – an allegorical story based on the myth of Prometheus – and the composer's piano version of the orchestral score was published not long after its premiere in 1801. Beethoven turned his symphonic style and skill in pictorial representation to conjure scenes of stormy excitement alongside elegant dances and the sublime aura of beauty surrounding the legendary musicians Orpheus, Amphion and Arion. The *Finale* is crowned by a theme that would later be used in the *'Eroica' Symphony*.

About Warren Lee

Warren Lee made his debut with the Hong Kong Philharmonic Orchestra at the age of six. A graduate of the Royal Academy of Music in London and the Yale School of Music, he was the First Prize winner of the Stravinsky Awards International Piano Competition and the Grand Prix Ivo Pogorelich in 1995. He has performed on four continents, often in collaboration with international artists and leading orchestras. His recordings for Universal Music (Hong Kong) and Naxos have garnered favourable reviews worldwide. A Steinway Artist as well as an award-winning composer, Warren Lee received the Ten Outstanding Young Persons Award in Hong Kong in 2012 and was elected an Associate of the Royal Academy of Music in 2015 for his contribution to the music profession. In 2017 he received the Ian Mininberg Distinguished Alumni Award from the Yale School of Music

- 2020 sees the 250th birthday anniversary of Beethoven. This
 new recording is one of many upcoming releases in celebration
 of the big event.
- While not being as ubiquitous as the symphonies and piano concertos, Beethoven's sublime score for *The Creatures of Prometheus* is justly popular in orchestral recordings. The version for piano presented here is however virtually unknown on disc, and will be a release of great interest to collectors and fans all over the world.
- Pianist Warren Lee's Naxos recordings include Liszt's Ungarischer Romanzero on 8.573805. He also accompanied violinist Hyejin Chung in performances of Friedrich Seitz's concertos for violin and piano (8.573801 and 8.573965) and Schubert's violin sonatinas (8.573579). Of the Schubert disc, Fanfare wrote: 'Lee's thoughtful accentuation provides constant interest as it underlies Chung's generally smoothly flowing lines.'

Louis KARCHIN (b. 1951) Jane Eyre

Over four decades the American composer Louis Karchin has produced a much-admired portfolio of compositions. His one-act opera Romulus (8.669030) won numerous accolades. Jane Eyre is his largest project to date, in which he and librettist Diane Osen fashion Charlotte Brontë's beloved novel into a vivid and moving opera cast as a fluid and continuous entity. Karchin's wide-ranging harmonic language and his flair for contrast ensure that the novel's drama, its pastoral elements, and most importantly its characterization are fully developed via arias, monologues, ariosi and a quartet, to create a boldly engaging new work.

Key Features:

Louis Karchin has produced over 90 compositions, and co-founded new music groups including the Orchestra of the League of Composers, the Chamber Players of the League/ISCM (International Society for Contemporary Music), the Washington Square Ensemble and the Harvard Group for New Music. The debut album of his first opera, Romulus (8.669030), was hailed as one of the best recordings of 2011 by Fanfare magazine, and a choice of the month in BBC Music Magazine.






This recording features the original cast of the world premiere production in 2016. The title role was sung by soprano Jennifer Zetlan, in which Opera News described her performance as 'nothing short of heroic. Zetlan was also featured in a recent release of Falla's El amor brujo and El retablo de Maese Pedro with the Perspectives Ensemble and conductor Angel Gil-Ordóñez (8.573890).

This world premiere recording of four recent orchestral works by acclaimed composer Dan Locklair opens with the powerful Symphony No. 2 'America', the orchestral fireworks of which celebrate three significant American holidays. This work was summed up by Classical Voice North Carolina as 'soon-to-be-a-hit' for its highly rhythmical and lyrical character, typical features of Locklair's music. Hail the Coming Day is a festive celebration of the consolidation of the towns of Winston and Salem in 1913, while the antiphonal dialogues of PHOENIX celebrate new life. The Concerto for Organ and Orchestra movingly unites ancient and modern musical techniques to create a work of dazzling and exquisite beauty.


The music of Dan Locklair is widely performed throughout the US, Canada and the world. His many awards have included consecutive ASCAP Awards since 1981. Renowned as an organist, Locklair is famously known for his organ work Rubrics, considered one of the most popular 20th/21st-century American solo organ piece all over the world.



Conductor Kirk Trevor also conducted Locklair's Symphony of Seasons (Symphony No.1) and Harp Concerto on American Classics 8.559337. Fanfare commented: 'Performances are excellent and the recording quality top notch.' Together with the Slovak National Symphony Orchestra they also presented the world premiere recording of Carson Cooman's Nantucket Dreaming cycle (8.559655), and Judith Lang Zaimont's Chroma Northern Lights (8.559619).

Tchaikovsky's Violin Concerto is the quintessential national virtuoso showpiece, but other Russian composers have contributed strongly to the genre of works for solo violin and orchestra. Tchaikovsky's student Taneyev, who rose to eminence in Moscow, wrote a memorable Suite de Concert that followed the model of the Baroque suite while infiltrating it with warm lyricism and brilliant variations. Earlier, Rimsky-Korsakov had written a Fantasia on Two Russian Themes that explored virtuoso potential in a concerto form that is both seductive and vibrant.

Kev Features:

- The Ukraine-based Kyiv Virtuosi Symphony Orchestra, together with its artistic director Dmitry Yablonsky, has presented several recordings of works by 20th-century composers. Their recording of Valentin Silvestrov's Moments of Memory II, The Messenger - 1996 and Silent Music (8.573772) was nominated for an International Classical Music Award (ICMA), and described by Fanfare as 'beautiful, sensitive performances that make a strong impression even though they never raise their voices.
- American violinist Annelle K. Gregory is the First Prize and Audience Choice Award winner of the 2017 National Sphinx Competition, and the laureate of the 2013 Stradivarius International Violin Competition. Her love of Russian music has led her to revive forgotten works of great Russian composers - in 2017 she released an album of Rachmaninov's complete works and transcriptions for violin.



Dmitry Yablonsky is also a world-renowned cellist. His recording of Khachaturian's Cello Concerto (8.570463) was highly praised by MusicWeb International: 'the finest available performance of the Khachaturian Cello Concerto, and as such merits the strongest possible recommendation... Yablonsky's playing [is] breathtaking.'

Leopold Hofmann was among the most prominent Viennese composers of his generation, his music performed all over Europe. Hofmann's radiant flute concertos follow the conventions of the day with superlative elegance and a deceptive facility. The solo writing has a lightness, grace and agility perfectly suited to the instrument's strengths, particularly in the lovely and often rhapsodic slow movements. It is hardly surprising that musicians and audiences found these concertos so beguiling, and they have lost none of their magic today.

Kev Features:

- Aside from the two previous volumes of the Flute Concertos (8.554747 and 8.554748), we also released Hofmann's concertos for cello (8.553853), violin (8.554233) and oboe (8.553979), as well as the five symphonies (8.553866), as part of the '18th-Century Classics' series.
- Flautist Uwe Grodd has made world premiere recordings of more than 80 works of 18th and early 19th-century music. His recording of Kuhlau's Flute Sonatas, Op. 83 (8.555346) was awarded '3 stars and key' rating by The Penguin Guide: 'highly sympathetic performances on modern instruments, which do not try to over-dramatize or trivialize the music with exaggerated bravura. The recording is excellent and this disc is another real Naxos discovery.'




The Czech Chamber Philharmonic Orchestra Pardubice and conductor Michael Halász are household names in the Naxos catalogue. They recently released a collection of Russian works for cello and orchestra with cellist Li-Wei Qin (8.573860), in which Gramophone commented: 'everyone delivers a fully invested and no-quibbles attractive Russian sound.'

George KONTOGIORGOS (b. 1945) Dancing with Centaurs

Stories for Saxophone

Stathis Mavrommatis, Saxophone • Christina Panteli, Piano The Orchestra of Colours • Miltos Logiadis

The music of George Kontogiorgos generates a mystical soundworld inspired largely by the stories and creatures of Greek mythology. Although primarily tonal, his compositions encompass a broad spectrum of music from minimalism to atonality. *Dancing with Centaurs* contains melodic elements found in fragments of ancient Hellenic music and traditional songs from Asia Minor, interwoven with the pentatonic scale. *Night Walk* is redolent of the Hellenic mainland in its structure and freely expressive performance, while the *Concertino 'Testosterone'* features novel sound effects including saxophone multiphonics.

Key Features:

Award-winning composer **George Kontogiorgos** was much in demand as a popular songwriter during the 1960s and '70s, but has dedicated himself to concert music since the 1980s. Hardly any of this music has become commercially available on recordings, but we made a start in 2013 with a digital exclusive release of his string quartets (9.70198). The striking quality of *Dancing with Centaurs*, presented as part of our Greek Classics series, will establish Kontogiorgos's reputation still further.




Soloist **Stathis Mavrommatis** is an important figure in the saxophone world, being a founding member of the Hellenic Saxophone Association, first alto saxophonist of the Athens Wind Orchestra, and a professor of saxophone at the 'F.Nakas' Conservatory of Athens and with no fewer than twelve concertos dedicated to him by distinguished Greek and international composers.



 Pianist Christina Panteli has performed widely as a soloist, and as a member of an innovative piano duo alongside Helena Christodoulou. She has been working with Stathis Mavrommatis since 2005, and this duo has performed and broadcast in Greece and internationally.

Carl Maria von Weber's achievements as a composer were considerable and influential, demonstrating new possibilities in opera and orchestration, particularly in the handling of wind instruments. His attractive, lyrical style is ideal for the making of arrangements, and the impressive and beautifully proportioned *Flute Sonata* is a virtuoso masterpiece, as is the operatic *Grand Duo Concertant*. There is a feeling of solemnity in the *G minor Trio*, an unusual work with an enigma at its heart: the song-like *Schäfer's Klage* or 'Shepherd's lament' – the origins of which remain a source of conjecture.

Key Features:

Flautist Kazunori Seo is a prizewinner of international competitions, notably the Carl Nielsen and Jean-Pierre Rampal in 1998, the Geneva in 2001 and the Pro Musicis International Award in Paris in 2005, and has gained recognition as one of the world's outstanding flautists. His Naxos recordings currently include Flute Concertos by Leopold Hofmann (8.554747 and 8.554748), music by Karl and Franz Doppler (8.570378) and Wilhelm Friedemann Bach (8.573768).




Pianist **Makoto Ueno** has previously collaborated with Kazunori Seo, recording works by Ignaz Moscheles (8.573175), Carl Czerny (8.573335) and the second volume of Beethoven's Works for Flute series (8.573570). The Moscheles disc was an *American Record Guide* 'Critic's Choice': 'Whether he is accompanying a sonata or a divertimento, Makoto Ueno has lots to do and executes it with clarity, sensitivity, and superb balance.'



Cellist Shohei Uwamori is a graduate of the Tokyo University of the Arts and the Universität der Künste Berlin. He has been awarded the Hideo Saito Memorial Fund Award, which he received from the Sony Music Foundation after being recognised by Seiji Ozawa and Tsuyoshi Tsutsumi as the most promising cellist in 2016, and First Prize at the 66th Music Competition of Japan.

Thomas Simaku, whose music has been described as 'visionary and entirely original' is one of the most fascinating and important of contemporary composers. His blend of intensity and modernism is exemplified in this selection of chamber and instrumental works, all performed by the dedicatees, each of which reveals different facets of his art. Playfulness of texture can be savoured in Signals, whereas virtuosity is a feature of Capriccioso. The architecture and vocal quality of ENgREnage show the rich variety of contrasts and harmonic colours that Simaku evokes in his music.

Key Features:

Multi-award-winning composer Thomas Simaku's works have been selected by international juries in no less than nine editions of ISCM World Music Days, and has featured at international festivals including Huddersfield, Tanglewood, Miami, Muzički Biennale Zagreb, Weimar, Munich, Rome, Viitassari (Finland), Beijing, Innsbruck (Austria) and Warsaw Autumn among others. His album of String Quartets Nos. 2 and 3 (8.570428) received much critical acclaim.



Ferdinand Ries is remembered as Beethoven's one-time pupil, secretary and copyist, but the discovery of his many compositions showed him to be a forward-looking composer in his own right. The 1799 Cello Sonata in C minor is among the first of its genre, the 15-year-old Ries already showing remarkable talent in its 'Sturm und Drang' moods. The Trio, Op. 63 was admired in its day for its 'ingenuity of modulations', and fashionable London society lapped up the exotic themes of works such as Introduction and a Russian Dance and the virtuosic Trois Airs Russes Variés. Volume 1 of this edition can be found on Naxos 8.573726.



It became his largest cycle to date and marks Messiaen's first use of 'communicable language', in which each letter of the alphabet is assigned a unique pitch and note-value, thereby translating text into music. Haunting harmonies, awe-inspiring monumental grandeur and the deepest profundity of expression are contrasted by the innocence of birdsong with the recurrent call of the yellowhammer, a tranquil voice from nature amid kaleidoscopic Biblical themes.

This new release is **Tom Winpenny**'s fifth recording of Messiaen's organ music for Naxos. 

Also known as *The Black Sheep* and *The Two Brothers*, *La Rabouilleuse* is one of the *Scènes de la vie de province* in Balzac's *La Comédie humaine*.



In this romantic and raw adventure set in the untamed wilderness of Wyoming of 1886, an anonymous college graduate ventures out West where he encounters gun fights, lynching, cattle rustlers, high-stake poker games, Indian attacks, and a brave, honest and imposing cowboy known simply as the Virginian. Presented as the archetypal, ideal hero of the 'western' genre (which was novelised for the very first time in this same book), the Virginian, a foreman at Shiloh Ranch, carries a strong sense of justice that wins him the heart of independent young schoolteacher Molly Stark, and finds his sworn enemy Trampas at the end of a gun. The novel developed many of the central tropes and themes of the western, including morality, faith and honour, and presents its formidable, unforgiving landscape in stunning detail.
